Fortnightly Update

Paving on the intersection of Wells Street

Paving is now underway on the Scramble crossing within the construction area behind the barriers at the intersection of Young and Wells Street. The pavers at this intersection are made from a mix of different sized Porphyry natural stone and are designed to be slip resistant.

Change in turning conditions on Ross Smith Avenue

Turning into Ross Smith Avenue from Young Street southbound will still be possible, however the roundabout will be temporarily converted to a 'stop and give way' arrangement. Drivers will be required to stop give way before turning right into Ross Smith Avenue. This change will allow us to work on the road surface and build the bus bay on the east side (station side of Young Street).

Night works

There will be ongoing works through the night and weekend works until project completion. Extra work crews are now on the ground. These night works will involve the full road closure of Young Street from 10pm to 7am. Pedestrian access along the street will not be affected and services to shops will be accessible as usual.

Car park changed to 2P free parking

We have listened to trader feedback and the car park at 122 Young Street has been changed from 1 hour free parking to 2 hour free parking from 9am to 6pm, allowing customers more time to visit local shops.

What we have been working on

- We have completed the majority of the concrete bus stop pavements on the east side (Train Station side).
- Preliminary works along the footpath on the west side (shop side) are well underway.

What we are doing next

We'll be contacting traders to let them know when paving outside their business will take place as soon as this information is available. Shops will always be accessible and some of the concreting paving in front of shops will need to be done overnight to help maintain access to shops.
