Works on Young Street will be complete by the end of October 2017, with some minor completion activities to be concluded shortly thereafter.

By the end of October, you'll see:

- vehicle traffic using Young Street in both directions,
- traffic lights operating at Wells Street and Station Street,
- bus operations relocated back to Young Street at upgraded bus stops,
- new paving in place on both sides of Young Street.
- kerbside parking reinstated on Young Street.



Parking changes

122 Young Street Car Park

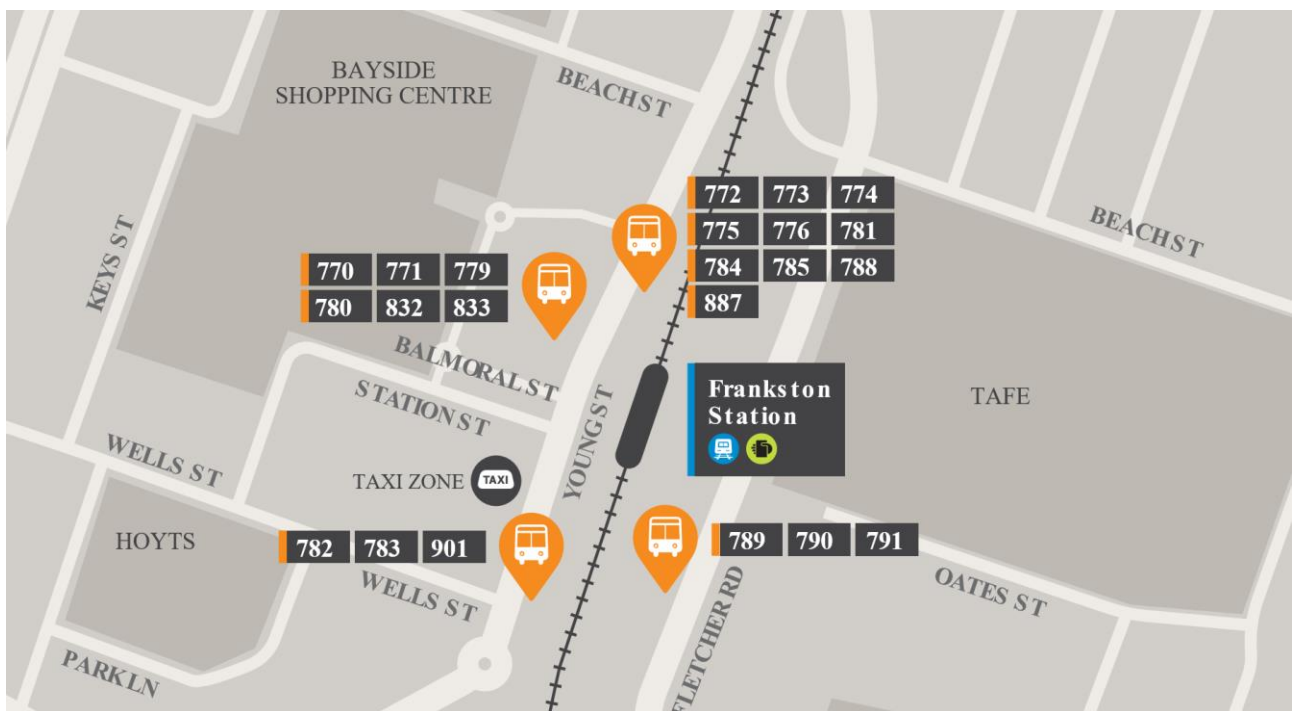
At the end of October, this carpark will no longer be a 2-hour car park and will revert to all day paid parking.

Parking on Young Street South and Beach Street

Parking on Young Street South and Beach Street will be reinstated when bus stops are relocated back to Young Street at the end of October.

Bus Stops back on Young Street

Bus stops will be relocated back to Young Street at the end of October. Please note – these are the locations for the relocated bus stops on Young Street.



Temporary Generators on Young Street

There are two temporary generators on Young Street to operate traffic signals and lighting until the power is switched over by the power company. These generators will emit low noise and will be removed as soon as the power is switched. We are working with the power company to achieve this as soon as possible and expect these will be in place for 2 to 3 weeks. The generators are in front of 64 Young Street and at the intersection of Young and Wells Street.

Business as Usual competition

As part of the Business as Usual campaign, the State Government is working in partnership with Frankston City Council and the Frankston Business Network for an in-store shopping competition throughout October and November. Frankston Station works

The Level Crossing Removal Authority (LXRA) will oversee the delivery of the new Frankston station, the centrepiece of the Victorian Government's \$63 million Frankston Station Precinct Redevelopment.

LXRA will be building the new station at the same time as the removal of the Skye/Overton Road, Frankston level crossing.

In March 2017, the Minister for Public Transport declared Genton Architecture the winner of the Frankston Station Design Competition. Genton is working with LXRA to refine the winning design to take account of rail operational needs.

The Young Street Improvement Project is one of several major redevelopment projects happening in Frankston City. Council is not managing these projects, however is committed to keeping residents informed about what's happening and how traffic will be affected.
